MOTION TO DISMISS

11 **WARREN STEED JEFFS,**
12 Defendant.

13 The State of Arizona, by the Mohave County Attorney, hereby moves the Court
14 for an order dismissing Two Counts of Sexual Conduct with a Minor in cause number
15 CR-2007-0743 and the Two Counts of Sexual Conduct with a Minor in cause number
16 CR-2007-0953, all charges being Class 6 Felonies, for the reason that the two victims in
17 these cases no longer desire to proceed with prosecution in the State of Arizona for the
18 following reasons:

19 (1) The Defendant has already served more jail time in Arizona than he would
20 receive even if he was convicted of all crimes charged;

21 (2) The State of Texas has much more serious charges against the Defendant
22 that involve the Defendant being the direct perpetrator of the crime, and both Texas and
23 the victims want the Defendant to face these more serious charges as soon as possible;

24 (3) The State of Texas has already started extradition proceedings against the
25 Defendant;

1 (4) The Defendant, Warren Jeffs, had significant medical problems while
2 incarcerated in the Mohave County Jail, and the State believes that he should be
3 transferred to another facility as soon as possible;


4 (5) Some of the State's witnesses no longer desire to testify in the State of
5 Arizona due to the above-mentioned circumstances;

6 (6) It would be impractical and unnecessary to spend taxpayer money on this
7 Defendant under all the above mentioned circumstances;

8 The State requests the dismissals in Cause No. CR-2007-0743 and CR-2007-
9 0953 to both be With Prejudice.

10 Defense Attorney, Michael Piccarreta, has been contacted and does not oppose
11 this Motion or Order.
