We are just ordinary citizens who share a concern for the welfare and safety of the women and children living in polygamy.

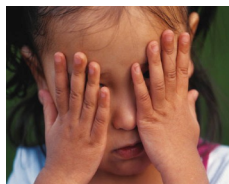
We are advocates working to make a difference in the lives of the women and the boys and girls, who have left this culture.
